

Wedding News Policy

The Dillon Herald welcomes your engagement and wedding news.

The Dillon Herald will print wedding articles with a black and white photo up to 24 column inches at no charge.

The 24 column inches of free wedding news includes a large black and white wedding photograph (approximately two columns wide by six inches high) and 11 column inches of type.

It is necessary that wedding news in the excess of 24 column inches of space be purchased at our current display advertising rate.

Space limitations are imposed because of expenses involved in publishing and in order to be fair to all who would like their wedding news published in The Dillon Herald.

Forms are available at our office to assist in the writing of the wedding article.

Two-column color wedding photos will be run at a charge of \$60 and run as space is available.

Wedding news more than three months old will be billed in their entirety with no free inches given. We will not print weddings even with payment that are one year or more old.

Engagements:

Engagements with a black and white picture and basic information are printed free of charge as long as our form is used with no additions or a write-up of similar length is submitted.

Engagements that do not exceed space limitations with a two-column color photos will be run at a charge of \$60.

Wedding Parties, Showers, Luncheons, Etc.:

Additional news running separately from the wedding

regarding wedding parties, showers, luncheons, etc. will run at no charge provided they are submitted prior to the wedding and in a timely manner (NO LATER THAN TWO WEEKS AFTER THE EVENT).

Wedding parties, showers, luncheons, etc. submitted late (after the two week period) will be billed, and those submitted as part of the wedding article will be included in the free 24 column inches and any excess will be billed accordingly.

Photos:

We do not accept matte or textured finish photos due to their poor reproduction quality.

Photos may be submitted in color or black and white; however, they will be printed in black and white unless color is purchased.

Close up photos with light backgrounds usually work best.

Errors:

The Dillon Herald requests that persons submitting wedding news proofread articles before publication.

If an article is not proofread, the newspaper will only print a line correction.

We will not print the entire article.

We will also not reprint articles due to print quality.

Weddings and engagements will not be reprinted due to the failure of the person submitting the announcement to include all information.

Placement:

Weddings may appear in the Tuesday or the Thursday issue as space is available.

Charges:

Any charges incurred must be paid in full prior to printing the wedding news.
